The Youth Employment Service (YES) provide support for young people aged 14 to 19 (or up to 25 in certain cases), helping you access employment, education or training. We will help you take responsibility for your decisions about education and your career.



Changes to the age young people leave education...

Young people are required to stay in education or training until the academic year when they reach the age of 17. From summer 2015, this will rise to 18.

Your choices

From the age of 16 you will have a choice about how you want to learn or study. These options include:

- staying in full-time education at school or college, or home education
- staying in part-time education or training if you are employed, self employed or volunteering for more than 20 hours per week
- work-based learning such as an apprenticeship or traineeship.
