# Why buy locally produced food?

## North Somerset Local Food Directory

Although people frequently say that they would prefer to shop or source food locally it's not always that easy. This new edition of the popular North Somerset Local Food Directory is designed to enable you to quickly and easily find over 50 local producers and retailers in and around North Somerset.

The directory has been compiled by the Economic Development team at North Somerset Council and builds upon the work of the Taste of North Somerset Partnership who were key to the production of previous editions.

The producers and retailers are all from North Somerset and the immediate area to reflect local shopping habits and include producers that add to and compliment the range and quality of North Somerset produce.

## Local produce in North Somerset

An incredibly diverse range of fresh, local and seasonal produce is available across North Somerset. This leaflet lists an amazing array of over 50 local producers and retailers where you can find all sorts of locally reared meat, smoked fish, cheese, dairy products, traditionally baked goods, fruit and vegetables, chutneys, real ale and cider. We're also realistic though, and some prepared food is listed if it's made locally, in an artisan way, and from great ingredients.

## 'Shop local in North Somerset'



The directory is part of the 'Shop local in North Somerset' campaign to encourage people to support their local independent businesses. Buying locally-produced goods or spending money in local businesses helps to keep the wealth circulating in our communities. If every resident of North Somerset each spent just 36p a week on local food (that is 10% of the national average weekly spend on fruit and vegetables), it would generate over £74,000 for our local economy. This would be an extra £3.8 million circulating locally each year.

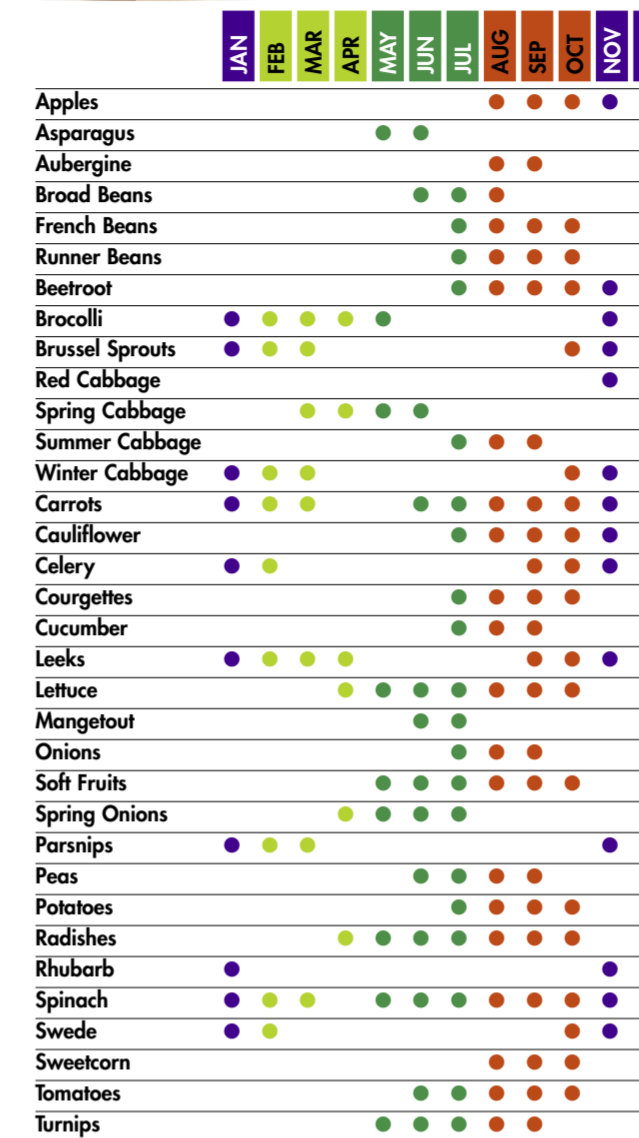
## Local purchasing

Local purchasing means you are supporting local businesses, the local economy and the local environment - this leaflet shows how easily you can buy direct from many local producers, through veg and meat box schemes, Farmers' Markets, farm shops, Country and Village markets and your local retailer.

So, keep supermarket shopping to a minimum and make your shopping experience a more local, pleasurable and sociable experience rather than a dreaded chore.

## Why buy locally produced food?

- It supports the local economy and creates more jobs for local people
- It helps to boost the local economy - £10 spent with a local food business generates £25 for the local area, compared to the £14 generated by a £10 spend in a supermarket
- Good value for money - local vegetables and meat bought at markets can, on average, be 30% cheaper than those from supermarkets
- Helps reduce unnecessary waste by buying what you need more often as opposed to the fortnightly supermarket shop
- Less packaging and food that is not pre-packed is likely to have less additives and preservatives
- Fresh food often tastes better because it has travelled less distance
- Traceability - it's generally easier to trace local food back to its origins - so you can be reassured as to where and how your food has been produced
- Farmers' Markets create high knock-on spending in other shops on market days
- Locally grown produce will naturally be seasonal
- It helps to reduce the number of lorries on our roads - food is responsible for more lorries on our roads than any other commodity



## Seasonality

Supermarkets increasingly stock out of season produce imported from all over the world. People are forgetting that food grows in seasons. Buying seasonal produce will create a demand for food that can be sourced locally.

## Local distinctiveness

There are over 3000 known varieties of apples, many of which are grown here in the South West but most supermarkets only stock a limited number of common varieties. Consequently many British varieties are being lost. Buying locally distinctive produce and varieties will help their survival.

## Healthy eating and physical activity



Choosing local food can help you keep healthy - the key to a healthy diet is variety. Base meals on starchy foods like wholemeal bread, potatoes and pasta. Include lots of lovely fruit and veg, some protein like meat, fish, eggs or lentils and some milk and dairy foods.

Try to do around 30 minutes of physical activity every day - a walk to the farm shop or Farmers' Market will get you active and you can pick up some local produce at the same time.

Allotments are a great way to grow your own fruit and vegetables, it's affordable, a good source of quality food, fun, sociable and a great form of exercise. You can even 'grow your own' at home if you have a window box or use containers in small gardens.

Due to the increasing demand for allotments many communities are exploring new ways of growing and buying produce by developing community growing spaces, Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) projects and establishing local food co-ops. 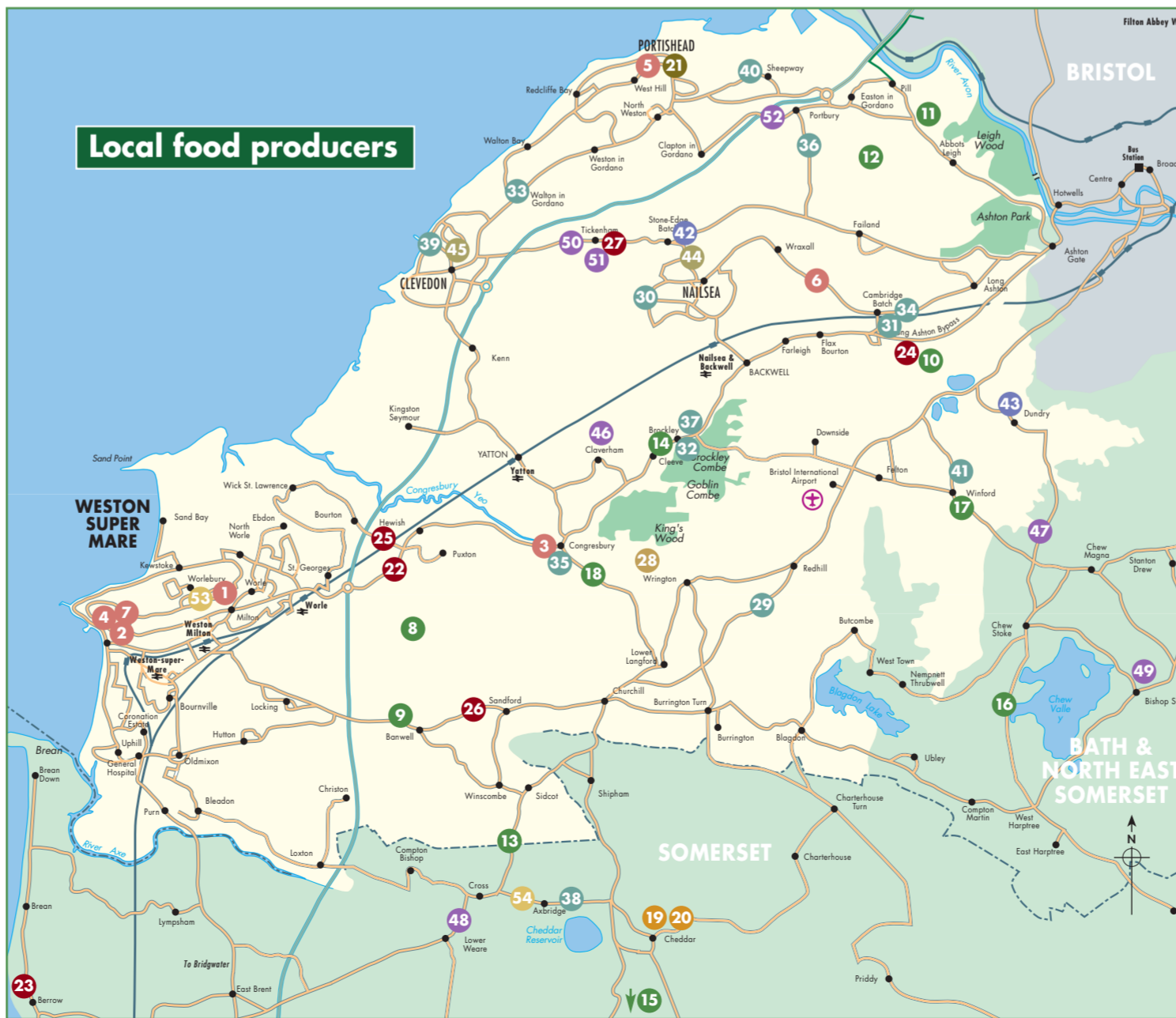
